With their accomplishments celebrated and bright futures ahead, the Spring 2025 graduates are ready to make a positive and lasting impact on the world. Congratulations to all!











And now — here we are. Dressed up. Holding our degrees."






"We collaborated with peers from 82 nationalities." We pitched in English, networked in Korean, and joked in French.
